Friday, September 4

Mount Precipice: Start off with a stunning panoramic view of Nazareth and the Jezreel Valley.

Nazareth: Visit the town Jesus grew up in (Matthew 2:19-23).

Cana: See the location of Jesus' first miracle of changing water into wine (John 2:1-11).

Overnight: Sea of Galilee



Saturday, September 5

Mount of Beatitudes: Learn about the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5:1-12).

Tabgha: Visit the Church of the Multiplication of Loaves and Fish (Matthew 14:13-21).

Church of the Primacy of St. Peter: Witness where Jesus appeared to His disciples after His resurrection (John 21:1-19).

Capernaum: Visit the place where our Messiah ministered in fulfilling prophecy.

Bethsaida: See the hometown of Peter, as well as where Jesus healed the blind man (Mark 8:22-26).

Kursi: Learn how Jesus set free two demon-possessed men (Luke 8:26-39)

Sea of Galilee: Enjoy a relaxing boat ride on the waters Jesus walked upon.

Sunday, September 6

Jericho: Visit Tel Jericho to learn about Joshua (Josh. 6:1-27), see the Mount of Temptation (Luke 4:1-13), and stand near Zacchaeus' sycamore tree where Jesus spoke to him (Luke 19:1-10).

Good Samaritan Inn: Briefly explore archeological remains at the same location where the Samaritan stopped to help a stranger (Luke 10:25-37).

Mount of Olives: Witness a panoramic view of Jerusalem from where Jesus wept over the city (Luke 19:41-44) and learn about the magnificent prophecies regarding His return (Zechariah 14).

Garden of Gethsemane: Walk amongst 2,000-year-old olive trees and take time to pray at the location of the Agony of Jesus (Luke 22:39-53).

Overnight: Jerusalem

Monday, September 7

Bethlehem: Explore Manger Square and the Basilica of the Nativity to see where Jesus' birth was announced to the shepherds (Luke 2:1-7).

Mount Zion: Visit the upper room where Jesus held the Last Supper with His disciples (Luke 22:7-38).

Western Wall: See the only remains of the Second Temple in Jerusalem and the most holy place in the world for all Jewry.

Garden Tomb: Witness the location where Jesus was thought to be crucified, buried and where He rose from the dead (Matthew 27).

Overnight: Jerusalem



Tuesday, September 8

Old Jaffa: Walk around the ancient port from where Jonah tried to flee to Tarshish, learn about the stories of Aeneas and Dorcas, Cornelius' calling to Peter and Peter's vision from God (Acts 9-10).

Caesarea Maritima: Explore the remains of the 2,000-year-old port, theatre and stadiums built by Herod. This is also the apostle Paul's departure point from which he fulfilled Jesus' command in Acts 1:8. **Ben Gurion Airport:** Say goodbye to Israel and fly to Greece to continue in the footsteps of the apostle Paul and see how he brought the Good News to all nations.

Overnight: Thessaloniki, Greece



Wednesday, September 9

Kavala: See the beautiful port of Phillipi.

Phillipi: Enter the ruins and explore the forum, market, basilica and theatre in the place where Paul preached his first sermon and baptized the first believers in Europe. See the baptismal site where Lydia, the first European woman, was baptized, and the crypt where Paul was imprisoned (Acts 16).

Overnight: Thessaloniki



Thursday, September 10

Thessaloniki: Enjoy a short tour of the city in which Paul preached (Acts 17:1-9).

Veria: Step into the Church of the Apostle Paul, where Paul, Silas, and Timothy preached to the welcoming Berean people for many days (Acts 17:10-15).

Vergina: Visit the Royal Tombs before heading to Kalambaka.

Overnight: Kalambaka

September 3 - 14, 2020



Friday, September 11

Meteora: Visit the breathtaking rock tower monasteries of the 11th century and the cliff-high Great Meteoron Monastery of Varlaam from the 16th century.

Monastery of Saint Stephen: Admire Byzantine items and articles that belonged to the early believers in a museum located within the walls of the Monastery before traveling to Delphi.

Overnight: Delphi



Saturday, September 12

Delphi: Explore the hometown of the famous oracle and one of the most important religious centers in the world. Our tour will lead us through the marketplace, Sacred Way, and ancient ruins of the treasuries of the Athenians. We will continue through more Roman structures that are still in-tact, such as the Temple of Apollo, the Tripod of Plataea, stadiums, and museums.

Athens: Learn about this famous ancient city through an indepth tour, including a visit to the Acropolis museum.

Overnight: Athens



Sunday, September 13

Acropolis and the "Areopagus": See where Paul stood and preached to the Athenians (Acts 17:16-34).

Corinth: Wander around one of Paul's most beloved cities and the inspiration for two of his letters. Visit the Cathedral of St. Paul, walk the nearby market, and see the world famous Corinth Canal.

Monday, September 14

In the morning, we will head to the airport for our flight back home.

Tour Cost:

- Full Tour Package price is \$4,225, with a minimum of 20 total passengers on the tour.
- Ground-only price is \$2,975 (passenger is responsible to arrange and pay for their own air travel).
- The listed price is for double room occupancy. If you wish to have a single room, an extra **\$900** is required by the hotels.

- Six nights hotel accommodation in Greece on half board basis (breakfast & dinner).
- One-way Aegean Airlines/Olympic Air flight TLV-SKG (Taxes included). Including Ground Only travelers.
- Entrance fees to all sites and attractions as per itinerary.
- English-speaking tour guide.
- · First-class air-conditioned tourist coach bus.
- · Tips to hotel staff.
