HOPE FOR ISRAEL



Sunday, March 3rd

- Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport, Israel by noon time to meet up with the tour.
- **Tel Sheva:** Wander the remains of the patriarch Abraham's city and well.

Overnight: Sede Boker

Monday, March 4th

- **Tel Arad:** Explore King Solomon's hill fortress that served as protection for Israel's southern trade routes.
- **Bedouin lunch and camel ride:** A time you'll never forget!
- **Makhtesh Gadol:** Stare in awe at the panoramic desert scenery above the world's largest erosion crater in the Negev.

Overnight: Sede Boker

Tuesday, March 5th

- **Ein Avdat:** Hike through beautiful canyons along the Zin stream while experiencing Israeli nature at its best.
- **Paran:** Enter the wilderness where Moses sent out the twelve "spies."
- **Masada:** Tour King Herod's renowned mountaintop palace as you learn about the backdrop of Israel's "never again" mentality.

Overnight: Dead Sea

Wednesday, March 6th

- **Ein Gedi:** Meander through the stunning desert oasis in which David hid out in caves while hiding from Saul.
- **Dead Sea:** Spend a relaxing afternoon floating in the healing waters of the lowest point on Earth.

Thursday, March 7th

- **Jordan River:** Learn about our Messiah's immersion.
- **Jericho:** Discover the oldest continuously inhabited city in the world while walking amongst ancient remains from the time of Joshua.

Overnight: Sea of Galilee

Friday, March 8th

- **Zippori:** Visit the Jewish capital of the Galilee during the time of Yeshua.
- **Nazareth:** Encounter the city where Yeshua was raised and called home.

- **Kibbutz Ginegar:** Hear from locals to discover the importance of the kibbutz movement for modern Israel.
- **Carmel Mountain:** Stand victorious in the place where Elijah publicly defeated the prophets of Baal.
- **Daliat El Carmel:** Experience Druze hospitality with a family whose lives were forever changed by a suicide bomber.

Overnight: Sea of Galilee

Saturday, March 9th

- **Capernaum:** Explore the area in which our Messiah ministered, fulfilling prophecy.
- **Kursi:** Hear the Yeshua story of the man freed from demons.
- **Bethsaida:** Learn about many of our Messiah's important teachings while standing where He taught them.
- **Mt Arbel:** Enjoy the breathtaking view of the Sea of Galilee from on high.
- **Magdala:** Visit the home of Mary, who Yeshua healed from demons.

Overnight: Sea of Galilee

Sunday, March 10th

- **Tel Dan:** Walk through an Eden-like haven filled with rivers and greenery while discussing the site's biblical heritage.
- **Caesarea Philippi:** Understand the context of Peter's powerful statement, "Yeshua, you are the Messiah!"
- **Oz 77:** Hear the story of the miraculous beginning to the Yom Kippur war.
- **Sea of Galilee:** Take a leisurely boat ride on the waters that bring to life countless biblical passages.

Overnight: Sea of Galilee

Monday, March 11th

- **Mt. Gerizim & Samaria:** Walk on the Mount of Blessings, known both as an important place of worship for the Samaritan people and as Northern Israel's capital.
- **Shiloh:** Tour the site of the Tabernacle from the days of the Tanakh (Old Testament).
- **Beth El:** Experience the site where Abram first built an altar to the Lord and where Jacob had his "stairway to heaven" dream.

Overnight: Jerusalem

Tuesday, March 12th

- **Beth Lechem:** Spend time in the area where Yeshua's birth was announced to the shepherds and see David's well.
- **Ein Haniya:** Walk the "desert road to Gaza" where Philip immersed the Ethiopian Eunuch.

Overnight: Jerusalem

Wednesday, March 13th

- **Hebron:** Visit the ancient Tomb of the Patriarchs.
- **Susya:** Wander this archaeologically fascinating ancient synagogue and her well-preserved mosaics.
- **Carmel Jeep tour:** Experience the beautiful Judean desert up close and personal.

Overnight: Jerusalem

Thursday, March 14th

- **City of David:** Explore the stunning capital of ancient Israel and the site of many significant biblical stories.
- **Davidson Center:** Walk amongst archeological proof for our faith.
- **Pool of Siloam:** Stand next to the location of the healing of the blind man.
- **Western Wall & Temple Tunnels:** Spend time praying at the remains of the Temple, also known as the holiest site in the world for the Jewish people.
- **Pool of Bethesda:** Learn more about the story of the healing of the invalid at the pools of "moving water".
- **Garden Tomb:** Take time in this peaceful location to remember the Messiah's crucifixion, burial and resurrection.

Overnight: Jerusalem

Friday, March 15th

- **Beit Lid:** Learn about the double suicide bombing that changed Moran Rosenblit's life forever.
- **Caesarea Maritima:** Surround yourself in the ruins of this spectacular Mediterranean port, which served as Paul's departure point.
- **Joppa:** Visit to the ancient port city from where Jonah and Peter trace their historic journeys.

- **Tzora and Esthaul:** Visit Samson's birthplace, ministry, death and burial location.

Overnight: Jerusalem

Saturday, March 16th

- **Valley of Elah:** Scout the site of the historic battle between David and Goliath.
- **Tel Tzafit:** Explore the hometown of Goliath.
- **Tziklag:** Visit David's home away from home before becoming King of Israel.
- **Gaza Border:** Hear stories of the reality of living in modern-day Israel on the border with Gaza.

Overnight: Jerusalem

Sunday, March 17th

- **Yad Vashem:** Gain a better understanding of the Jews during WWII at the world-famous Holocaust Museum.
- **Kidron Valley:** Walk along the famous Kidron valley to view the 3000 year old Pillar of Absalom, Tomb of Beanie Chazir and Zacharias's tomb.
- **Gethsemane:** Meander through the olive grove where Yeshua prayed the night before His crucifixion.
- **Mt. of Olives:** Overlook the Temple Mount and Eastern Gate while studying its significance to the End Times.
- **Farewell Dinner:** Say goodbye to Israel by enjoying a delicious farewell dinner at one of our favorite Jerusalem restaurants.
